# IMPORTANT - THIS COMMUNICATION AFFECTS YOUR PROPERTY TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 (As amended by the Planning and Compensation Act 1991) ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

#### ISSUED BY HINCKLEY & BOSWORTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears that there has been a breach of planning control, under section 171A(1)(a) of the above Act, at the land described below. It considers that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

#### 2. THE LAND AFFECTED

23C Wood Street, Hinckley, Leicestershire, LE10 1JQ ("the Unit") which is shown edged red on the plan annexed ("Planning Enforcement Notice Plan").

#### 3. THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL ALLEGED

Without planning permission the change of use of the Unit the current lawful use of which falls within Use Class B2 to a dog day care and grooming centre (Sui Generis Use) (shown edged red on the attached plan).

#### 4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

a) The change of use results in the partial loss of an employment unit within a designated employment site. This property is allocated as a Category B

employment site within the Council's Employment Land and Premises Study

(2013); within the most recent review of the study it was recommended that

100% of these premises be retained for uses falling within Use Classes B1, B2 or

B8. Therefore the loss of this unit would be contrary to Policy DM19 of the

adopted Site Allocations and Development Management Policies Development

Plan Document (2016).

b) It is evident that the change of use has occurred within the last 10 years and it is

expedient for the Council as the Local Planning Authority to take enforcement

action to remedy the breach of planning control.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO:-

Cease the use of the unit for the operation of a dog day care and dog grooming centre.

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE:

One (1) month after this notice takes effect.

DATE WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT 7.

This notice will take effect on (6 February 2017) unless an appeal is made against it

beforehand.

#### YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

You can appeal against this notice, but any appeal must be received, or posted in time to be **received**, by the Secretary of State **before** the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice. The enclosed leaflet "HOW TO COMPLETE YOUR ENFORCEMENT APPEAL FORM" sets out your rights and how to lodge your appeal. If you wish to lodge an appeal you must contact the Planning Inspectorate in the first instance for the forms to be sent to you.

If you appeal and wish the appeal under ground (a) or the deemed planning application to be considered a fee of £770.00 is payable. Fee must be paid to the Council (cheque

made payable to Hinckley & Bosworth BC). The Planning Inspectorate will notify you of the date by when this fee must be paid.

### WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL

If you do not appeal against this enforcement notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period(s) specified in paragraph 6 of the notice. Failure to comply with an enforcement notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
