ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY HINCKLEY & BOSWORTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to it that there has been a breach of planning control, under section 171A(1)(a) of the above Act, at the land described below. It considers that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. THE LAND AFFECTED

Land Adjacent To, White Cottage, 5 Church Walks, Stoke Golding, Nuneaton ("the Land") which is shown edged red on the plan annexed ("the Plan").

THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL ALLEGED

Without planning permission the material change of use of the land from agriculture to a use for the storage of building materials

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

a) In the opinion of the Local Planning Authority the storage of building materials on an open piece of land within the Stoke Golding Conservation Area detracts from

the character of this sensitive area and is contrary to Policy DM11 and DM12 of

the Site Allocations and Development Management Policies DPD.

In the opinion of the Local Planning Authority the storage of builder's materials b)

adjacent to a Grade I Listed Building has an adverse impact on the building and its

setting and is contrary to Policy DM11 and DM12 of the Site Allocations and

Development Management Policies DPD.

The Council considers that the adverse impacts of the unauthorised change of use C)

cannot be satisfactorily mitigated by the use of planning conditions. It is evident

that the change of use of the land to a builder's storage yard has occurred within

the last 10 years and it is expedient for the Council as the Local Planning Authority

to take enforcement action to remedy the breach of planning control.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO:-

Cease the use of the land as a builder's storage yard a)

Remove all materials associated with this use from the land. b)

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE:

One month after this notice takes effect.

7. DATE WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice will take effect on 10 May 2018 unless an appeal is made against it

beforehand.




WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL

If you do not appeal against this enforcement notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period(s) specified in paragraph 6 of the notice. Failure to comply with an enforcement notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
