ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY HINCKLEY & BOSWORTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to it that there has been a breach of planning control, under section 171A(1)(a) of the above Act, at the land described below. It considers that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. THE LAND AFFECTED

The Land at Street Record, Veros Lane, Nailstone, Leicestershire, ("the Land") which is shown edged red on the plan annexed ("the Plan").

3. THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL ALLEGED

Without planning permission the laying of hard standing

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

a) In the opinion of the local planning authority the laying of hard standing at this location within the open countryside introduces an incongruous and unsustainable form of development which would have a significant adverse impact on the

intrinsic value, beauty, open character and landscape character of the countryside and is contrary to Policy DM4 and DM10 of the Site Allocations and Development Management Policies DPD.

b) The site is located adjacent to the Nailstone Conservation Area and the laying of hard standing fails to preserve or enhance the character of this sensitive area which is contrary to Policy DM11 and DM12 of the Site Allocations and Development Management Policies DPD.

c) The Council consider that the adverse impacts of the development cannot be satisfactorily mitigated by the use of planning conditions. It is evident that the development has occurred within the last four years and it is expedient for the Council as the local planning authority to take enforcement action to remedy the breach of planning control.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO:-

a) Remove all hard standing and associated materials

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE:

One month after this notice takes effect.

7. DATE WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice will take effect on 10 May 2018 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

If you wish to lodge an appeal you must contact the Planning Inspectorate in the first instance for the forms to be sent to you.

If you appeal and wish the appeal under ground (a) or the deemed planning application to be considered a fee of £468.00 is payable. Fee must be paid to the Council (cheque made payable to Hinckley & Bosworth BC). The Planning Inspectorate will notify you of the date by when this fee must be paid.


WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL
